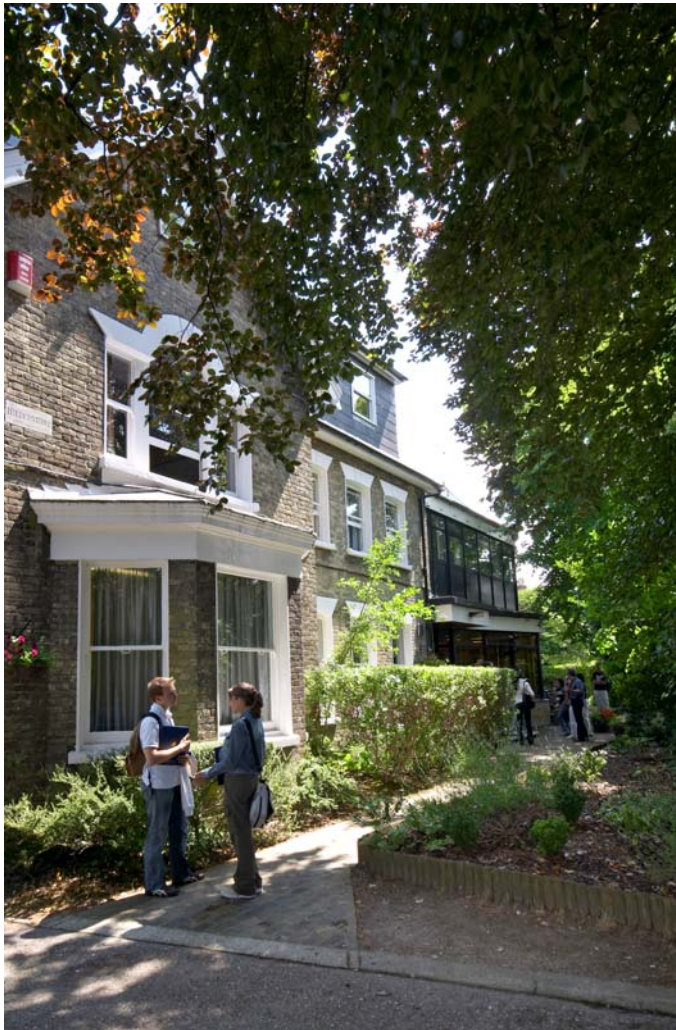

DATES & FEES 2010

- Students in host family accommodation should arrive and depart on the dates below.
- All classes begin on the day after the Arrival Date.
- All courses offer a minimum of 25 hours (25 x 60 minutes) academic programme per week, (21 hours of classes and 4+ hours supervised self-access study and/or examination practice). In addition, there is a full programme of social and cultural activities.
- Annual average 9 students per class, maximum 12.

- All students will be charged a single Registration Fee of £50.

COMBINATION COURSES (FOR EXECUTIVES AND PROFESSIONALS)

Specially arranged intensive courses for executives and all business or professional people (lawyers, doctors, teachers, government employees etc.). These combine 21 hours per week in an international Intensive English group, plus 2 hours per week specialist English one-to-one. Courses from September to June, 2 weeks minimum, £338 per week. Accommodation with host family £100 / £103 per week, or hotel by arrangement.

HOW TO ENROL

ENTRY INTO COURSES

- Students are normally accepted from the age of 17 upwards.
- There are separate classes for all levels.
- Complete beginners cannot normally be accepted. Please contact us if you are unsure of your level.

Long Courses:

Enrolment is usually for the complete course. Short periods (minimum of 2 weeks) are also possible – please see “SHORT COURSES” overleaf for details.

National Holidays:

There will be no classes on Intensive English Courses, Pre-University Courses or Cambridge Examinations on the national holidays of 5 April, 3 May, 31 May and 30 August 2010.

ENROLMENT

Fill in the enrolment form and return it with *either* the full course fee *or* a deposit of £100 to the address overleaf (or enrol online at www.hilderstone.ac.uk).

The deposit counts towards your fees and is not an additional payment.

FEES (ALL COURSES)

You must make a payment in advance: *either* the total fees *or* a deposit of £100.

ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT LEAST 2 WEEKS BEFORE THE START OF YOUR COURSE.

Fees include: all tuition and teaching materials, use of self-access study facilities, e-mail and internet access, local visits and participation in Hilderstone’s cultural and social programme. Regular excursions and optional activities are provided at a small extra charge. Accommodation is arranged with a local host family: single room, breakfast and evening meal on weekdays, and all meals at weekends. The cost of examinations is not included in the course fees.

“Special Discounted Fees” for Intensive English, Pre-University and Cambridge Examinations (see inside →):

These Special Discounted Fees are only available to long-stay students who enrol and **pay in advance for the full period.**

In addition to course fees, there is a single Registration Fee of £50.

CANCELLATION OR CHANGES TO ENROLMENT

- The deposit of £100 is not refundable if we have accepted your enrolment. 2 full weeks’ notice is required for any cancellation before your course start date.
- Tuition fees cannot be refunded for any part of the current course after your course start date.
- Any additional course may be cancelled and a refund made, with 2 full weeks’ notice. Fees will be recalculated and a cancellation charge made of £100.
- 7 days’ notice (or a half-week’s compensation) is required for a refund of accommodation fees or for a change of host family.
- Any break during a course must be requested before the beginning of a course. (“Special Discount” students enrolled for 30+ weeks may request a holiday break of 1 or 2 weeks, which can be added to the end of their enrolment period.)
- The College reserves the right to cancel a course, or to close a class, if demand is insufficient.
